- A suggestion was made to include an advocacy section on the website. This section could be used to provide members with sample letters for expressing our current concerns about foreign language education. We could also use this section to showcase the community and global outreach performed by local foreign language teachers and their students.

NYS AFLT Update: Barbara Allen

- NYS AFLT Colloquium will be held in Albany April 29-30th.
- Concerns have been expressed about new state graduation requirements; foreign language exams provided by the state are not explicitly mentioned under the new guidelines.

Scholarships:

- Charlene had communicated with teachers and guidance counselors from Syracuse City School District as well as Jamesville-Dewitt and has received no responses. Deadline for all scholarships is Friday April 15.
- NYS AFLT has chosen scholarship winners for our region; these awards will be presented at our May Celebration.
