

The Henry C. and Dorothy R. Shoudy Memorial Scholarship Application



Deadline: April 1, 2013

Description: The Henry C. and Dorothy Shoudy Memorial Scholarship is given annually to a graduating senior who is pursuing a degree in Spanish or teaching of any world language. The applicant must be enrolled in the Syracuse City School District or the Jamesville-DeWitt School District. The winning candidate will be presented with a certificate and a \$1,700 check at the LECNY May Celebration, which will be held May 15, 2013.

Dorothy R. Shoudy was a Spanish language teacher at Jamesville-DeWitt until 1972. She was an active member of both the New York State Association of Foreign Language Teachers (NYS AFLT) and FLACNY, which is now known as Language Educators of Central New York (LECNY). In 1969, Mrs. Shoudy was named the NYSAFLT Wasley Distinguished Foreign Language Teacher of the Year. After retiring in 1972, she continued to teach adult education Spanish classes at Syracuse University, University College, Carrier Corporation, and most recently at Manlius Pebble Hill School.

Because of her passion and dedication for teaching a world language, the Henry C. and Dorothy R. Shoudy Memorial Scholarship was established at her death for the benefit of world language students pursuing a career in world language education. Each year, a scholarship will be awarded to a Syracuse City School District or Jamesville-DeWitt School District student who is pursuing a career in Spanish and/or world language education. LECNY will assist the Community Foundation in naming the recipient.

Scholarship Eligibility:

- The applicant must be a graduating senior who has successfully completed multiple years of world language study.
- The applicant must be college bound, with aspirations of pursuing a degree in Spanish or the teaching of any world language.
- The applicant must be enrolled in the Syracuse City School District or the Jamesville-DeWitt School District.
- If the applicant is not currently enrolled in a world language class, please indicate the most recent class(es) and teacher.

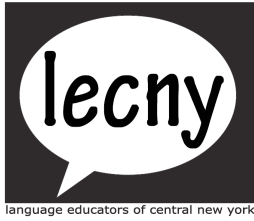
