



Language Educators of Central New York Teacher Classroom Grant Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of the LECNY Teacher Classroom Grant?

The purpose of the LECNY Teacher Classroom Grant is to reward and recognize LOTE educators for developing, implementing, and evaluating programs that make an impact on teaching and learning languages other than English. This grant is available to public and non-public school educators, PreK-12, who are members, in good standing, of the Language Educators of Central New York.

What is the LECNY Teacher Classroom Grant?

It is a \$100.00 grant available to LECNY member language teachers for use to institute, develop or continue a LOTE program. It may be used for classroom, language club and/or language honor society programs. It may be used for supplies and materials necessary to the program. *It may NOT be used for travel expenses, conference fees, substitute pay, membership fees, or compensation.*

What is the timeline?

Applications are available in February. Proposals must include the Application, Checklist and Narrative. The proposal must be postmarked on or before August 1st. The grant winner(s) will be notified on or before September 1st. The grant award will be presented at the LECNY September meeting. The grant must be implemented during the 2012-13 school year.

Who evaluates the grant applications?

The applications will be read and rated by a LECNY committee and rated using a rubric to be published on the LECNY website. (www.lecny.org)

What methods of dissemination are acceptable?

If granted the Teacher Classroom Grant, LECNY wishes that you share your project with the rest of the LECNY membership. Projects MAY be disseminated in any of the following ways:

- Submit an article to the LECNY newsletter (also available on our website)
- Present a workshop for LOTE teachers at a LECNY meeting or conference
- Provide program information for the LECNY website
- Other LECNY approved method
